Our 2012 Kismet CSA is a great way to help us expand our offerings while making 2012 your tastiest year ever. For the first time since 2008, we are offering a limited number of Kismet CSA shares. Sign up now to make sure you get great deals on the best bread, pastry, and organic fruit around. NOTE: There will be no u-pick in 2012.

SIGN UP NOW AND EARN BONUSES!

- **ALL 2012 Kismet CSA members earn a 5% bonus**, renewable for the life of your Kismet Card account (details on Sign-up Form)
- **Sign up by December 15th** and get an additional 5% Kismet credit.

Fruit + Bakery Share = \$700 (\$400 of fruit and \$300 of bakery goodies)

This share is for people who welcome abundant supplies of organic fruit throughout the growing season, and their choice of baked goods year 'round. You will pick up your fruit at the Road Stand* on your designated pick-up day, for approximately 13 fruit pickups, June to September. Baked goods may be ordered in advance, to be picked up with your fruit. Or just shop the Road Stand for baked goods. You will use your Kismet Card, loaded with your CSA bucks, for all pre-order Bakery and Road Stand purchases.

**Once we see where Fruit +Bakery Shareholders hail from, we may include a second Michigan location to drop shares.*

Shopper's Share = \$400

This share is for those who want fruit, pastries, and bread on a less structured schedule and in quantities that are more modest. Use your Kismet Card, loaded with your CSA bucks, to buy fresh, organic fruit and fresh baked goods at the Road Stand. You may also use your Kismet Card to purchase baked goods that you order in advance, from the availability list we will email you weekly.

How it works:

- 1) Print out the CSA sign-up form; declare yourself a Kismet CSA member by selecting your preference of share options. Then, mail us the completed form with a 50% deposit to secure your share. The balance will be due by April 15th.
- 2) Mid-May all CSA members will receive their Kismet cards (this will have your Road Stand/Bakery credit on it). Fruit+Bakery members will receive a fruit pick-up schedule; all members will get updates about the Bakery's opening date.
- 3) In June we will offer Strawberries and Heirloom Tomatoes (yes, really!), as well as spring veggies. Kismet CSA members will be the first to taste the spring flavors. We hope that the bakery will be open by then, but it may take a bit longer.
- 4) Once the bakery is open, you may place bakery orders to coincide with your fruit pick-up schedule or you can drop by and shop the Road Stand. CSA availability notices will arrive weekly, alerting you to what products and CSA-only specials we have that week.
- 5) Use your Kismet credit until it runs out – there is no expiration date. If you would like to “re-up” your account, you may do so at any time (as long as you still have a balance on it). **You will get a 5% bonus again** with a re-up minimum of \$200 (you will get \$210 on your card). Fruit Details for the Kismet Organic Fruit+Bakery Share, 2012

We will do our best to achieve optimum crop health and productivity, while using only methods and materials approved by the USDA for organic fruit production. There are no guarantees on fruit production—quantities or quality. The fruit may not look like conventionally grown fruit (it may be blemished or otherwise imperfect), but is perfectly good.
