1. CHOOSE WHAT KIND OF SHARE YOU'D LIKE

_____ **Fruit + Bakery Share = \$700 (\$400 of fruit and \$300 of bakery goodies)**

This share is for people who welcome abundant supplies of organic fruit throughout the growing season, and their choice of baked goods year 'round. You will pick up your fruit at the Road Stand* on your designated pick-up day, for approximately 13 fruit pickups, June to September. Baked goods may be ordered in advance, from the availability list we will email you weekly (to be picked up with your fruit). Or you can just shop the Road Stand for baked goods. You will use your Kismet Card, loaded with your CSA bucks, for all pre-order Bakery and Road Stand purchases.

*Once we see where Fruit +Bakery Shareholders hail from, we may include a second Michigan location to drop shares.

_____ **Shopper's Share = \$400**

This share is for those who want fruit, pastries, and bread on a less structured schedule and in quantities that are more modest. Use your Kismet Card, loaded with your CSA bucks, to buy fresh, organic fruit and fresh baked goods at the Road Stand. You may also use your Kismet Card to purchase baked goods that you order in advance, from the availability list we will email you weekly.

2. READ ABOUT THE BONUSES, ORDERING AND PICK-UP DETAILS, AND OTHER FINE PRINT

2012 CSA 5% Bonus All 2012 members receive a 5% bonus	\$400 will be applied towards your fruit share. \$335 (\$300 + 5% of \$700) will be credited to your Kismet Card for Bakery /Road Stand purchases.	\$420 (\$400 + 5%) will be credited to your Kismet Card for Bakery /Road Stand purchases.
Dec. 15 th 5% Bonus	If this form is received by December 15th , you will receive an additional 5% bonus on your account (for a 10% total bonus).	
Ordering	Pre-orders of bakery goods must be received 3 business days prior to the CSA designated pick up day. You will receive weekly bakery updates! You <u>do not</u> have to order bakery items each week, but you can if you want to make sure the bread you want is waiting for you at the Road Stand.	
Pick Up Schedule	<i>Fruit shares:</i> Shareholders will get a fruit pick-up schedule for the entire fruit season. (Details about this will be provided in the spring). If you are unable to pick up your share, please contact us 48 hours in advance for rescheduling options. For last-minute changes, please ask a friend to pick up for you.	We will confirm your bakery pick up date when you place an order.

The What	Fruit and Bakery Share (\$700)	Shopper's Share (\$400)
Account Charges	Your account will be charged when checking out at the Road Stand or when bakery orders are placed. If you do not pick up your bakery order on the designated date, it will be available at the Road Stand the next day. Orders unclaimed on day two will be donated to the local Kismet Common Good partner. No refunds or credits will be issued.	
Road Stand Shopping	All CSA members can shop the Road Stand using their Kismet cards <u>whenever</u> the Road Stand is open. Be sure to ask if there are any CSA specials when you are there.	
Re-upping your Account	If you maintain a positive balance and re-up in \$200 increments, you will receive a 5% bonus on your Kismet Card each time. This offer only applies to those who join the 2012 Kismet CSA. Kismet Cards are transferable but cannot be re-upped by anyone but you.

3. AGREEMENT AND CONTACT INFORMATION

By signing this form, I agree to the aforementioned terms. I understand that there are many conditions farmers cannot control and I trust that Kismet Fruit Farm, LLC. and its workers will do their best to achieve optimum crop health, while using only methods and materials approved by the USDA for organic fruit production. I understand the fruit may not look like conventionally-grown fruit (it may be blemished or otherwise imperfect), but is perfectly good. I understand that Kismet Bakery is not open yet. If unforeseen circumstances prevent the bakery's opening, I will have the choice of a full refund, or to use the balance for farm fruit and veggies.

I agree to send a 50% payment as a deposit (see above table) now, and the remaining balance by April 15, 2012.

I understand and accept the terms of the Kismet CSA membership, and look forward to the delicious food produced by the new Bakery!
